Dear Mrs. Walters:

This is to inform you that the purchase by the United States of America of the Southeast Quarter, (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter, (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) Section 25, Township 20 North, Range 5 East, M.D.M., Butte County, California, containing 40 acres of land, has been consummated; which purchase has been made that yourself and other Indians related to you may have a permanent home on this land. The above described land is the same land on which your home I visited during the month of November 1915 was located, and on which you informed me that you were born and had spent your entire life of 76 years.

This land has cost the United States Government \$160., besides considerable other expenses in bringing this purchase to close; and, now that same is to be your and your relations permanent home, I am sure that you will not only appreciate what the Government has done for you and your people, but that you and they, will take great interest in further improving the land and beautifying the home environments. I distinctly recall how very anxious you were that the Government would be able to purchase your home of long lifetime occupancy, and therefore, am sure that you will greatly rejoice that same is to be your home during the remainder of your life.
