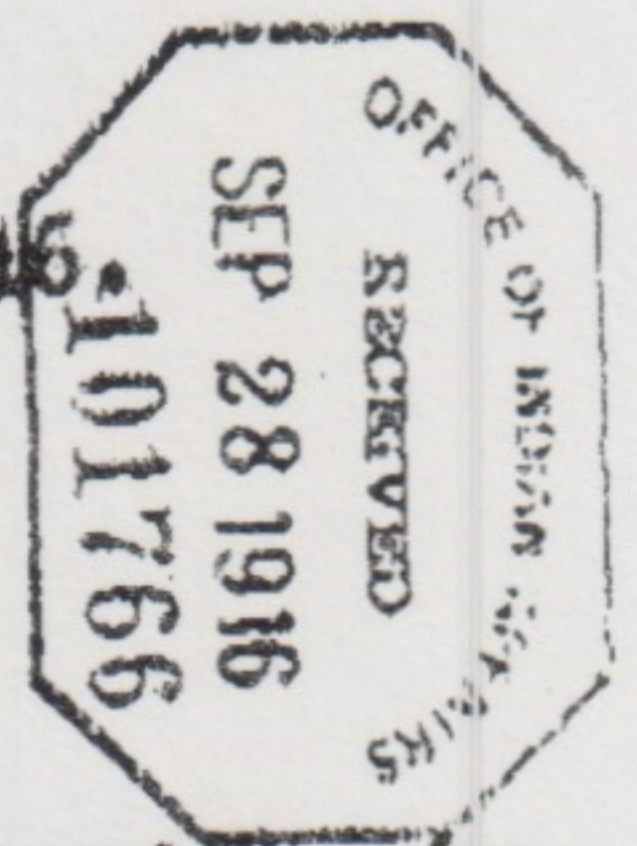

Dear Mrs. Martin:

This is to inform you that the purchase by the United States of America of Lot 3, Section 1, Township 19 North, Range 5 East, M.D.M., in Butte County, California, containing 40, and 64/100 acres of land, has been consummated, which purchase was made that yourself, your son, George, and his entire family may have a permanent home on this land.

The above described land is the same land on which your present home and all improvements are situated, being the same land that was entered and improved by your husband during his lifetime, and that was occupied by yourself, son George and his family at the time of my visit there during the month of November 1915.

This land has cost the United States Government \$162.56, besides considerable other expenses incurred in the consummation of the purchase; and now that same is to be your permanent home, I am sure that you will not only appreciate what the Government has done for you, your son George and his entire family, but that you will take much interest, as will also George and his family, in further improving and beautifying the land and home environments.
