Enterprise Rancheria held a General Council meeting to elect an Interim Tribal Council on Sunday, September 11, 1994 in Oroville, California. Enclosed are copies of the legal notices which were published in the Chico Enterprise Record and the Oroville Mercury Register. Also enclosed are copies of the Agenda and some materials which were distributed at the meeting.

Besides the legal notice in the two major local newspapers, notice of the meeting was specifically mailed to a number of interested parties. This included members of the Watson family, the Central California Agency of the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Miller & Associates, Berry Creek Rancheria, Chico Rancheria, Hoopa Valley Tribe, Mooretown Rancheria, and Round Valley Reservation.

* The meeting was open to all and observed by members of both Berry Creek (Gladys & Gus Martin, David Edwards) and Mooretown (Adrian Smith, Everett Smith) Rancherias. At the beginning of the meeting, three Watson brothers showed up and told everybody present that they "did not recognize this meeting" and that they "would protest this meeting." They acknowledged that they had received notice of the meeting. They were allowed to say everything they wanted to say. Even though they were welcome to stay and participate, these three individuals decided on their own to leave after they had finished speaking.

The General Council decided to elect seven (7) members to the Interim Council for one-year terms. I have also enclosed a large format copy of the sheet which was used to track nominations and votes. We have the original on file, along with the ballots, and the official forms which were used to validate the ballots. Two members of Berry Creek Rancheria (Gus Martin & Gladys Martin) verified the tabulation of, and counting of, the votes. The election results were as follows, with the top seven vote getters being elected:
