Flying in the face of their 2009 legislative agenda, and flying in the face of the unanimous position of the California State Association of Counties who staunchly oppose urban gaming and off-reservation tribal casinos, **John Gioia** flipped his position and voted to enter into a services agreement with the tribe behind the Pt. Molate Casino.
