## Casino Checklist

**More Crime** Crime rates around tribal casinos have increased by as much as 300% within 5 years of operation. Prostitution, theft, drug dealing, loan sharking, assault, gang related crime, rape, and murder.

**More Traffic** Pt. Molate Drive is the last eastern exit before the San Rafael Bridge toll plaza. With planned 24/7 operation, traffic will be bottlenecked around the clock throughout our thoroughfares.

**Lower Property Values** Property values in the areas surrounding Point Molate could plummet by as much as 70% with the combination of gaming, crime, and traffic.

**Loss of Authority** Once the land is transferred to the tribe, they are no longer answerable to local, county, state or federal statutes as they are their own *sovereign nation*.

## Poor Economic Return

Casinos in California are foundering. There are simply too many of them (58), and Richmond is not a desirable destination for any gamblers except for locals who can ill afford to lose what money they have.
